## Shopping Trips— Know Before You Go

- Shopping trip transportation is planned around medical appointments.
- Availability is limited to one trip per person per week.
- Up to two children under 18 may travel with a parent or guardian at no additional cost.
- Shoppers will be transported to the closest store that meets their needs.
- Space is limited—shoppers may bring two large or four small bags
  - Shoppers must be able to manage their own bags.
- Due to health concerns, transportation to/from the laundromat is not provided.
- Transportation for veterinary services is not provided.

### Bucksport to Ellsworth

- Free for Bucksport seniors
- First Tuesday each month
- 9:30 AM-1:00 PM

### Bucksport to Bangor

- Free for Bucksport seniors
- Third Tuesday each month
- 10:00 AM-1:45 PM

### Eastport to Eastport or Calais to Calais

- \$2.00 fee
- Fridays weekly
- Space and time permitting

### Machias to Machias

- \$2.00 fee
- Monday through Wednesday weekly
- Space and time permitting

\*From all other locations \$0.25 per mile
